

BRUSH CREEK VALLEY HOMESTEADS AND DITCH CLAIMANTS

Brush Creek Valley, Township 5 South, Range 84 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, the area at the mouth of Brush Creek between the Eagle River and the railroad tracks and west of Brush Creek. Ditch is Lower Rule, Priority #137, Spring in 1884, by H. E. Rule. The ditches are located by right bank or left bank and this is determined by facing downstream. This is supposed to be the original settlers of the Brush Creek Valley.

The Abrams family, one of the first permanent settlers in the area. They first settled about 2 miles up Abrams Creek. At that time, they pastured summer pasture on the open range and in the winter time pastured along Brush Creek in the swamp marsh grass, cattails, and brush type. They hadn't settled very long until the whole valley was homesteaded and fenced off so they had to move down the Abrams Creek along the edge of the valley. At their original home up the Abrams Creek, there is an Abrams daughter buried on a gyp point with a wooden fence around the grave.

Webb Frost were the cowboys. They pastured cattle in here, I believe, in 1879. Webb

Frost had two children that I knew, Gene Frost and Phoebe Frost Phillip. According to

Gene Frost, they had a sister which would have been another daughter of Webb Frost

who's buried in the field in an unmarked grave between Brush Creek and Salt Creek.
